

Rev. Neary Elevated To Monsignor Position

His Holiness Pope Paul VI has elevated the Rev. Thomas J. Neary, pastor of Madonna del Sasso parish, to be a Prelate of Honor to His Holiness with the title of Right Reverend Monsignor.

Msgr. Neary was born in Ireland on Feb. 10, 1924, educated in Ireland and was ordained to the priesthood June 20, 1948, at All Hollows College, Dublin, Ireland.

He arrived in the former Monterey - Fresno Diocese Oct. 10, 1948. Since then he has served as assistant pastor of parishes in Selma, Monterey, Fresno, and Sacred Heart Parish of Salinas. He was chaplain to the Atascadero State Hospital as well as resident priest at Santa Margarita. Following that he was appointed pastor of Madonna del Sasso Parish, Salinas, in October, 1961.

With the establishment of the new Diocese of Monterey, he was appointed chancellor, Dec. 14, 1967.

Msgr. Neary has two brothers, John and James Neary living in New York; and two brothers, Patrick and Michael, and one sister, Mrs. Brian Sheehan, living in Ireland.
