

Msgr. J.P. Haverty, Lee summer visitor

LEE — Monsignor John Paul Haverty, 69, pastor of Blessed Sacrament Church in West Brighton, L.I., and a frequent summer visitor here, died at Staten Island Hospital Sunday after a short illness.

Monsignor Haverty was associated with schools administered by the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of New York since shortly after his ordination at St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City in 1936. In that same year he received a master's degree in education from the School of Education at Fordham University in New York City.

He was appointed assistant supervisor of the archdiocese schools in 1941, superintendent in 1953 and secretary of education in 1964. He retired in 1966.

Monsignor Haverty spent many summers in Lee at the home of his cousin, the late Mrs. Arthur Pease, and frequently visited Mrs. Pease's daughter, Mrs. Richard P. Davis of Navin Avenue.

During the last 10 years, he celebrated several masses at St. Mary's Church.

Besides Mrs. Davis, he is survived by a brother, James T. Haverty of Westport, Conn.
