Reverend Raymond J. Jean, 69, died Thursday, (June 7, 2001) at his home in Niantic. He was born in Willimantic on Sept. 18, 1931, the son of the late Wilfred and Antoinette (Marchand) Jean. He served as president of the Diocesan Priests' Senate from June 1979 until June 1981. Father Jean was appointed pastor of Notre Dame Parish, Durham, on Sept. 16, 1970. He served there until he was named pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, Gales Ferry, on Sept. 6, 1984. He resigned as pastor on May 6, 1990, and was assigned to a leave of absence. He is survived by a sister, Anita N. Jean of Willimantic; a brother and sister-in-law, Paul and Ann Jean of Fort Washington, MD; nephews, Andre Jean, Jr. and his wife Nancy of Brooklyn, NY, Sean Jean of Hermosa, CA, Daniel Jean of Atlanta, GA; niece, Michelle Jean of Willimantic; and a sister-in-law, Anne Marie Jean of Clinton. He was predeceased by a brother, Andre Jean. A funeral mass will be concelebrated Monday, June 11, 10:30 a.m., in St. Mary Church, Valley St., Willimantic. Bishop Daniel A.
