Born Arthur M. Poletti, the son of Emile and Abigail (Mead) Poletti of New Jersey, Rev. Father Adrian Poletti, C.P., professed vows with the Congregation of the Passionists in 1928, and was ordained to the priesthood at Scranton, Pennsylvania, on April 28, 1934. He served as an Air Force Chaplain at Thurleigh Airfield in Bedford, England during World War II, from 1942 to 1945, and he was then the pastor of St. Joseph's Monastery Church in Baltimore, Maryland, from 1951 to 1959. Starting in the 1960s, he was a field representative for *The Sign*, a Catholic magazine published by the Passionists, and he traveled to different parishes along the East Coast preaching and selling subscriptions. His brother, Rev. Father Harold Poletti, was also a Catholic priest of the Passionist Congregation. Rev. Father Adelbert Poletti, C.P., was their cousin.
