

Two Charleston Priests Await Ordination

CHARLESTON — Ordination services for two Catholic ministers will be held here May 12.

Archbishop Paul J. Hallinan of Atlanta will be in charge of the rites, to be held in the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist. He was bishop of the Diocese of Charleston before being appointed recently as the first archbishop of Atlanta. The archdiocese includes this state.

To be ordained are the Rev. Charles Bevis and the Rev. Eugene W. Kelly Jr.

On May 19, Archbishop Hallinan will ordain two priests at Columbia. The Rev. Jarmen Casey and the Rev. Walter P. Lee will be ordained at rites set for St. Joseph's Catholic Church in the capital city.
