COLLEGEVILLE — Rev. Dominic Joseph Keller O.S.B., 75, died Sunday at St. John's Abbey.

Services will be at 3 p.m. Tuesday at St. John's Abbey Church with Abbot John Eidenschink officiating. Burial will be in the Abbey Cemetery.

Reception of the body will be 7 p.m. today at St. John's Abbey Church. Friends may call at the church until the time of the funeral. Funeral arrangements are being made by Wenner Funeral Home, Cold Spring.

Rev. Keller was born Dec. 31, 1902, in New York, N.Y., to the late Henry and Theresa (Heberle) Keller.

He was professed as a monk July 11, 1926, and ordained into priesthood June 7, 1931.

During his life as monk and priest, Rev. Keller taught European history at St. John's from 1926-1942, Gregorian chant from 1942-1952, was director of dramatics from 1934-1966, was abbey choir master from 1945-1955, and taught speech and music appreciation from 1944-1973. He also served as chaplain to the students from 1939-1942. He retired from active work in 1973.

He was preceded in death by a sister and two brothers.
