He served St. Mathew Church, Monroe, La., before joining St. Cloud Diocese February 1953. Parishes he served in the Diocese include Assumption, Morris; St. Joseph, Foxhome; St. Joseph, Brushvale; St. Joseph, Clarissa; St. Alexius, West Union; St. Margaret, Lake Henry, and the Ople Parish for the past two years. He also lectured and wrote on stewardship.
