## Rev. James Rizer

A memorial service will be conducted June 20 for the Rev. James Lee Rizer of Richmond, formerly of Williamsburg, who died June 8 while undergoing heart surgery in a Roanoke hospital. He was 81.

Born in Syracuse, N.Y., the son of the late Helen M. and James L. Rizer. Rev. Rizer served parishes in Richmond for 10 years. He also served at St. Bede's Catholic Church in Williamsburg during 1977-80.

He became a priest at age 42 and began his work at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Richmond in the 1960s. He was ordained by the Catholic Diocese of Richmond in 1950.

Rev. Rizer served at Our Lady of Nazareth in Roanoke and continued his work at St. Mary Star of the Sea at Fort Monroe, Hampton; Our Lady of Blessed Sacrament in Port Richmond, (West Point); St. Mary's in Alexandria and Blessed Sacrament in Norfolk.

He served at St. Parick's Church in Richmond during 1962-64 and with St. Elizabeth's Church in Richmond during 1964-72. He had been a resident of Lynchburg since his retirement in 1980.

Rev. Rizer is survived by his sister, Harriet Warren of Hampton and one brother, John Rizer of Hampton.

The memorial service will be conducted at 9 a.m. June 20 at St. Bede's Catholic Church.

A Christian wake was conducted Sunday at Holy Cross Church in Lynchburg. A mass of Christian burial was conducted Monday at Holy Cross Church. Burial was Tuesday in Mount Calvary Cemetery in Richmond.
