

## Rev. Jerome Reisinger, 68, Arizona

The Rev. Jerome Reisinger was born March 8, 1925, in Collegeville to Rupert and Agnes (Wagner) Reisinger. He attended St. John's University and Seminary, Collegeville, and was ordained June 6, 1953 and did graduate studies at Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C. He was assigned to St. Mary's, Little Falls; Christ the King, Cambridge; was assistant director of Catholic Charities, Diocese of St. Cloud; superintendent of St. Cloud

Children's Home and St. Columbkille, St. Wendel; chaplain in the U.S. Army Active Reserve; St. James, Randall; director of pastoral services at St. Francis Medical Center, Breckenridge; St. Joseph, Brushvale; and chaplain at St. Francis Home, Breckenridge. He was involved in Catholic Hospital Association and National Association of Catholic Chaplains.

Survivors include sister and brother, Joan Menke and David, St. Cloud.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Esther.
