

Rev. Eugene Bailot

Retired Saugus pastor; at 77

A funeral Mass will be said today at 10 a.m. in St. Joseph's Church in Boston's West End for **Rev. Eugene J. Bailot**, 77, retired pastor of St. Margaret's Church in Saugus. He died Saturday in the Regina Cleri Home for Retired Priests in the West End.

Fr. **Bailot** was born in Boston and studied at St. John's Seminary, Brighton. He was ordained in 1937 at the Cathedral of the Holy Cross in the South End by the then Bishop Francis Spellman and was then assigned to St. Anthony's Church in Cohasset.

He was an assistant pastor at St. Paul's Church in Wellesley from 1937 to 1940; at Holy Family Parish in Rockland from 1940 to 1943; at the Harvard Chaplain's School from 1943 to 1946, and at Our Lady of Mercy Church in Belmont from 1946 to 1952.

Fr. **Bailot** received his master's degree in education from Boston University in 1952.

He was an assistant pastor at St. Thomas Aquinas Church in Jamaica Plain from 1952 to 1955, at St. Thomas' Church in Bridgewater until 1957 and at St. Raphael's in West Medford until 1964. He served briefly as an assistant pastor at Sacred Heart Parish in Cambridge.

In 1964, Fr. **Bailot** became pastor of St. Thecla's Church in Pembroke. He was pastor of St. Margaret's in Saugus from 1968 until his retirement in 1975.

He leaves a brother, Louis **Bailot** of Melrose.

Burial will be at New Calvary Cemetery in Mattapan.
