Brother John Casula of the Marion Shrine in West Haverstraw died Tuesday, Aug. 2, 1994, in California. He was 74.

He was born March 23, 1920, in Osilo, Italy, to Antonio and Maria Gaspa Casula.

Professed as a Salesian of Don Bosco in Italy on August 16, 1941, he worked on various agricultural assignments before coming to the United States in 1947 where he continued working and teaching in agriculture in West Haverstraw.

He also taught automotive technology in 1962 for 27 years at Mary Help of Christians School in Tampa, Fla.

All family members have died before him.
