Phila. Priest He<mark>ld for Fraud</mark>

The Rev. William C. Dodgsor a priest at St. Paul's Catholi Church, 10th and Christian sts Philadelphia, was arrested Frida on charges of fraudulent conversion and obtaining money unde false pretenses.

Two complainants told Judg Vincent A. Carroll, sitting as committing magistrate, that the gave the 30-year-old priest mone, to buy automobiles and never received the cars or got their mone, back.

Father Dodgson was held in \$25,000 bail for a hearing nex Wednesday and committed to county prison in default. He did not wear clerical garb at the hear ing.

One of the complainants, Rob ert Kane, 2321 McClelland st. testified that he gave Father Dodgson checks for \$1700 and \$25 cash on April 28 for a new car.

The other complainant, Charles J. McKeown Jr., 3008 W. Girard ave., testified that on May 3 he gave a check for \$2232 to a mutual friend who was to give it to the priest for a 1955 Buick.

Police and seven other complaints are pending. Altogether, they said, the complaints involve \$14,700.

Police said Father Dodgson told them that he used the money to send a cousin through seminary and for other family obligations.

Police also said Father Dodgson was a \$100 and \$200 bettor at race tracks and won as much as \$7500 in a day. He give his address as Lebanon ave., near st., Philadelphia.
