SIDNEY HALL OBITUARY

Rev. Sidney P. Hall, who served since 1957 as a priest of the Diocese of Sacramento, died Sept. 13. He was 85. He retired from active ministry in 2002. Bishop Jaime Soto will preside at a funeral Mass on Monday, Sept. 19 at 10 a.m. in the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament, 1017 11th Street in Sacramento. Burial will follow the Mass at St. Mary's Cemetery, 6700 21st Ave. in Sacramento. A vigil will be celebrated on Sunday, Sept. 18 at 6:15 p.m. in the Cathedral. Visitation will precede the vigil from 12 noon to 4 p.m. at George L. Klumpp Chapel of Flowers, 2691 Riverside Blvd. Rev. Hall was ordained on May 11, 1957, after completing studies for the priesthood at St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park. He served as pastor of St. Peter Parish in Sacramento from 1994 to 2002, of St. Paul Parish in Knights Landing from 1973 to 1978, and of St. Christopher Parish in Galt from 1982 to 1986. He also served as associate pastor at the Cathedral, St. Peter Parish and St. Patrick Parish in Placerville. He served in the diocese's Hispanic Apostolate and was involved in Cursillo and Marriage Encounter. He was preceded in death by his parents, Sidney and Mary Hall; sister Patricia Swars; sister-in-law Gail Ann Hall; niece Lynne Swars; and nephew Gregg Swars. He is survived by brothers John (Liane), David (Diana) and Jerome (Joan); sister Rosemary Ridge (Brian); and numerous nephews, nieces and god-children. His family wishes to thank the staff of Mercy McMahon Terrace for all the love, care and kindness to Father Hall during his nine years of residence there.
