Ministers To Exchange

Ministers of Fort Worth and Dallas Unitarian churches will exchange pulpits for the 11 a.m. services on New Year's Day.

The Rev. James P. Wilkes, minister of First Church at Dallas, will speak in the Unitarian Church of Fort Worth, 2800 Purington. The local minister, the Rev. Walter Baese, will speak in the Dallas church.

The Dallas minister, a former Roman Catholic priest, entered the Unitarian ministry in 1958 and served churches at Boston, Mass., Washington, D.C., and Albuquerque, N.M., before going to Dallas over a year ago. He is active in national and regional denominational affairs and is a board member of the American Civil Liberties Union at Dallas.
