School Gets New Principal

The Rev. Louis H. Prefontaine, who was ordained a priest in Rome 17 years ago, has been named the new principal of St. Charles School which reopens Sept. 3.

The school at 1801 Hazeldine SE, includes all eight grades and kindergarten. Four lay teachers and four sisters are instructors at the school.

Taught Languages

Rev. Prefontaine, 44, has previously taught Latin, Greek, French, geometry, sociology and educational psychology.

He received his MS and Ph.D. degrees in education from Fordham University in the Bronx, N.Y.

Before coming to Albuquerque Rev. Prefontaine was teaching school in Cleveland, Ohio.

At Seminary

Rev. Prefontaine has also received a degree from Gregorian University in Rome.

He is presently president of the Minor Seminary Department of the National Catholic Education Association and on the planning committee and executive board of the NCEA.
