

Sister Walsh

Sister Mary Geraldine Walsh, 86, a member of the Sisters of Mercy and a parochial school teacher in Maine many years, died Thursday at St. Joseph's convent in Portland.

Sister Mary Geraldine was born in Quebec City, Sept. 6, 1887, the daughter of William H. and Mary A. Fitzgerald Walsh.

She attended St. Louis Academy, Quebec City, and later graduated from St. Joseph's College as an elementary school teacher.

She became a nun in December of 1910, and celebrated her Golden Jubilee in 1960, her Diamond Jubilee in 1970.

Sister Mary Geraldine taught in Brunswick, Biddeford, Sanford, Old Town, Bangor, Bath and Calais parochial schools, and served as principal in Portland at Sacred Heart, St. Dominic's and St. Patrick's. She taught at St. Joseph's College.

She is survived by two nephews, William and Mark Walsh, both of Quebec.
