

MALACHY MACARTEN McGINN

Former S.B. resident

Former San Bernardino resident Monsignor **Malachy** Macarten **McGinn**, 66, of Palm Springs died Friday of cancer at home.

McGinn, a native of Bally Bay County, Ireland, lived in San Bernardino seven years.

He was the pastor of Our Lady of the Assumption Catholic Church in San Bernardino from 1974 to 1981. He also served at Blessed Sacrament Church in Twentynine Palms for two years, St. Margaret Mary Catholic Church in Chino for four years and St. Theresa Catholic Church in Palm Springs for 12 years.

Survivors include two brothers, Peter James of Castleblaney, Ireland, and Paul Anthony of Bronx, N.Y.; and two sisters, Alice Brennan of Bally Bay County, and Clare McCarville of Castleshene, Ireland.

Visitation will be from 5 to 9 p.m. Tuesday, with rosary at 7 p.m., both at St. Theresa Catholic Church, 2800 E. Ramon Road, Palm Springs. Funeral Mass will be at 11 a.m. Wednesday at St. Theresa Catholic Church. Interment will follow in Rockcorry, Ireland.
