Parochial Vicar at St. Thomas Aquinas Church in California, PA from August 25, 1985 to August 5, 1991. Pastor of St. Catherine of Siena Church in Wireton, PA from August 5, 1991 till Present. Father Huber is survived by his Father, John A. Huber of Valencia, PA; two sisters, Ida
