

Rev. John F. Campbell

Father Campbell, assistant pastor of St. Catharine of Alexandria Church, Brooklyn, is a native of this borough. He studied at St. Charles College and St. Dunstan's University, Prince Edward Island, Canada, and St. Bonaventure Seminary, Allegany, N. Y., and was ordained May 21, 1932.



He served as an assistant at the parishes of Blessed Sacrament and St. Catharine of Alexandria, both Brooklyn, and Feb. 5, 1944, became a chaplain in the Navy. While serving in this capacity he had the distinction of offering the Holy Sacrifice in the air, aboard a Navy blimp; on the sea, aboard an aircraft carrier, and under the sea, in a submarine.

He returned to parish work as an assistant at St. Catharine of Alexandria Oct. 26, 1946.

Father Campbell will offer a Mass of thanksgiving Tuesday, May 21, at 11 a.m., assisted by Rev. Raymond F. Rau of Little Flower parish, Brooklyn, deacon, and Rev. Francis L. Campbell of St. Catharine of Alexandria parish, Ontario, subdeacon. Father Rau and Father Campbell are nephew and cousin of the jubilarian, respectively.
