Rev. Cullinan, Mosinee, dies

The Rev. John Cullinan, 70, associate pastor of St. Paul's Catholic Church, Mosinee, died Tuesday noon at a Wausau hospital.

Funeral services will be held Friday at St. Paul's Catholic Church, Mosinee, at 11 a.m. The Most Rev. Fredrick W. Freking, Bishop of La Crosse, will be the celebrant. Burial will be in the parish Cemetery. Friends may call at the church after 2 p.m. Thursday, where there will be a St. Monica Society rosary said at 3:30 p.m. Thursday, and a parish rosary at 8 p.m. Thursday. Beste Funeral Home, Mosinee, is in charge of arrangements.

Father Cullinan was born May 4, 1904, in Chicago, Ill., son of Mr. and Mrs. John Cullinan. He attended St. Mary's College, St. Marys, Kan., where he was ordained June 21, 1939. He did post graduate work and taught at Loyola Academy, Chicago, Ill. He also taught at Xavier High School in Cincinnati, Ohio, and at St. Ignatius High School, Cleveland, Ohio. A priest in the diocese of La Crosse for 21 years, he served at St. Mary's Catholic Church, Wausau from 1952-56, and then at Mosinee until the time of his death.
