Rev. Edward Lucano,

Camden Diocese priest

CAMDEN — A Mass for the **Rev. Edward Lucano**, 58, former pastor of St. John Bosco Church, Millville, was said Monday in Garden City, N.Y.

Rev. Lucano, a priest of the Camden Diocese, died Thursday at Nassau Hospital, Mineola, N.Y., after a long illness.

A native of Brooklyn, N.Y., **Rev. Lucano** completed his seminary studies at St. Mary's Seminary, Baltimore, and was ordained to the priesthood in Camden in June 1949.

He served as associate pastor at Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Camden; St. Joseph's in Swedesboro; St. Cecilia's in Pennsauken; the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Camden; Holy Spirit in Atlantic City; Sacred Heart in Vineland; St. Theresa in Runnemede; St. Peter's in

Pleasantville; and Holy Rosary in Cherry Hill.

Rev. Lucano was appointed pastor of St. Mary's Church in the Rosenhayn section of Deerfield Township in June 1961. He served there until his assignment as pastor of St. **Edward's** in Pine Hill in August 1972.

In July 1975 he was appointed pastor at St. John Bosco Church in Millville, where he served until 1979.

At the time of his death, **Rev. Lucano** was on sick leave.

He is survived by two brothers, Vincent and William, both of Garden City, N.Y.

A Mass was said Monday at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Camden.

Burial was at Holy Rood Cemetery, Westbury, N.Y.
