

# T. J. Evans dies; retired Bel Air pastor

A Mass of Christian Burial for the Rev. Terence J. Evans, retired pastor of St. Margaret's Church in Bel Air, will be offered at 10 a.m. tomorrow at the Shrine of the Little Flower, Belair road and Brendan avenue.

Father Evans, who was 73 and lived at Stella Maris Hospice, died Saturday at St. Joseph Hospital after a short illness.

He retired in 1969 as pastor of the Bel Air church, a post he had held since 1958. During his pastorate, the present church and school were built.

After his retirement, Father Evans served as associate pastor at the Shrine of the Little Flower and as a chaplain to the Knights of Columbus.

Before being assigned to St. Margaret's, he was pastor of St. Mary's Church in Pylesville and an associate pastor at St. Dominic's Church in Baltimore and St. Augustine's Church in Washington. He was assigned to the Washington church when he was ordained in 1936.

Throughout his priesthood, Father Evans was active in the Legion of Mary. He was an expert on canon law and was active in the archdiocesan marriage tribunal.

Born in Baltimore, he was educated at St. Charles College and St. Mary's Seminary.

He is survived by a brother, Oscar Evans, of Parkville, a nephew and two nieces.

The family suggested that memorial donations be made to St. Mary's Seminary and University.
