Known victims are B , D , C and C

- The complaints by C and C are new and the investigation is only now underway.
- The complaints by B (1963-1966) and D have been recorded in 2002. B is in counseling.
- There is a letter in the chart of a complaint on April 25, 1966 by T R who may have been a Brophy Preparatory College student, but it is not clear whether or not he was.
- Father Doran seemed to take great offense from a note from Father Poirier. With Bishop Green and Father O'Dea he seemed to have been completely compliant (except, of course, that he did not actually change his behavior).
- There was a letter from Father P. J. Poirier indicating that the acting out continued: hugging boys, close association with a man who had a reputation for sexual acting out, a companion from the college (not clear if it was the preparatory college/high school or institution of higher education). There was a reference to another letter from another person who "brought the entire matter into the open."
- There was a significant confrontation in early 1958 by Bishop Green, with the consultation of Father Augustine O'Dea, regarding what seems to have been homosexuality, sex with minors, and alcohol abuse. Father Doran was sent to a "mutual friend" (apparently Father O'Dea) but the consultation was one time. They depended on Father Doran to see it through.

Father Doran died in 1997. His faculties were removed in 1994. He retired in 1990. He was ordained in 1945.
