Priest Held

MILWAUKEE, Wis. (AP)-FBI agents Friday arrested at Phoenix, Ariz., a 47-year-old chaplain wanted by Wisconsin authorities on a charge of kidnapping Miss Rosalie O'Connell, 17, from St. Mary's Hospital at Superior, Wis., Nov. 8.

The Rev. Lawrence Dudink was taken before a U.S. court commissioner in Phoenix on a federal charge of unlawful flight to avoid prosecution. He was held on \$5.000 bond.

Special agent Gerald C. Gearty of Milwaukee said Miss O'Connell was unharmed and had been turned over to juvenile authorities.

The FBI said a trail of checks written by Father Dudink, a Roman Catholic priest, during the past two weeks led westward. He and the girl were found at a motel near Phoenix after agents spotted his automobile.
