A story concerning City Council consideration of an obscenity ordinance contained an error.

The story incorrectly said Rev. Joseph Carne sent a 17-year-old boy to an adult book store and he successfully purchased a magazine. A radio station carried the same report.

Carne said Friday the youth acted on his own and was not directed by him or the Decency Through Law Committee.

The youth, Dean McKnight, bought the magazine at the Sensual Arts adult book store. Rev. Carne told Council.

McKnight told Escanaba Public Safety officers he bought the magazine at the store and had Robert B. VanEffen as a witness.

The store clerk, questioned by public safety officers, said he sold the book to a man about 30 years old and that the youth did not enter the store.
