Priest driving wrong way killed in crash in Columbus

columbus (AP) — A Catholic priest driving the wrong way was killed in a head-on collision, and police said several liquor containers were found in his car.

. The Rev. John P. Tague, 56, associate pastor of St. Francis of Assisi Parish, was driving north in the southbound lanes of Ohio 315, police said.

Police said toxicology tests had not been completed to determine whether he had been drinking, but said three empty 6.8-ounce "vodka martini" bottles were found in his car.

The driver of the other car, Neil Warling, 28, was hospitalized with a broken leg and ankle.
