Rev. Roger A. Emmert, 59, of Columbus, died February 1, 1997.

He was born October 26, 1937, to J. Charles and the late Katherine Turner Emmert. He was a priest of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Columbus for 34 years.

Surviving are his father, of Dayton; brother, John C. (Jack) Emmert and sister-in-law, Patricia Emmert, Cincinnati; aunt Frances G. Emmert, Dayton; and his brother priests of the Diocese of Columbus.

Rev. Emmert was a teacher at the old St. Charles College, St. Charles Prep School, old St. Joseph Academy, all in Columbus, and Summit County Day School, Cincinnati. He was an associate pastor of Holy Redeemer, Portsmouth, St. Thomas Apostle Church, and St. Joseph Cathedral, both in Columbus.
