### **BROTHER JOHN DEVOE, CFX**

On August 19, 2005, **BROTHER JOHN DEVOE, CFX**, died in St. Agnes Hospital from pancreatic cancer and pneumonia. **Brother John**, also known as **Brother Brennan**, was 74 at the time of his death. He excelled as a mathematics teacher and track coach at numerous schools throughout the United States, England and East Africa. His most recent assignment was at St. Mary's Ryken High School in southern Maryland.
