FARMINGTON — Monsignor James Lindenmeyer

March 1, 1922 - May 8, 2007

Monsignor James Lindenmeyer, 85, a priest of the Catholic Diocese of Gallup, died Tuesday, May 8, 2007, in Indiana. Monsignor Lindenmeyer was born March 1, 1922, in Batesville, Ind., to Dana Gilbert and Ferdinand Lindenmeyer.

He was preceded in death by his parents; and his sister, Mary Jones.

He is survived by his sister, Shirley Alton and her husband, Charles, of Shelbyville, Ind.; four nephews, three nieces; and 13 great-nieces and nephews.

He was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Gallup on Nov. 14, 1948, by Bishop Bernard T. Espelage, OFM. Monsignor Lindenmeyer served as a priest in the parishes of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Flagstaff, Ariz., from 1950 until 1960. When the Diocese of Phoenix was created, Monsignor Lindenmeyer was moved to ⊗

Lindenmeyer was elevated to the rank of "Domestic Prelate" by His Holiness, Pope Paul VI, and henceforth was known affectionately by all as Monsignor. Monsignor Lindenmeyer made his home in Farmington after his retirement until recently when his health forced him to move to Indiana where his family could care for him.

In Shelbyville, visitation will be from 4 to 6 p.m. Monday, May 14, followed by Mass at St. Joseph's Church.

In Farmington, a rosary-wake service will be held at 7 p.m. Thursday, May 17, at St. Mary's Church. Bishop Donald E. Pelotte, SSS will celebrate a funeral Mass at 11 a.m. at St. Mary's Church on Friday, May 18, followed by a burial at Greenlawn Cemetery.

At Monsignor Lindenmeyer's request, pallbearers and honorary pallbearers will be his brother priests of the Diocese of Gallup.

St. Mary's Church will host a reception after the burial at the St Mary's Parish Hall.
