Fr. Ildephonse (Edward) Skorup, O.F.M.

Manitowoc - Fr. Ildephonse Skorup, O.F.M., a Franciscan friar of the Sacred Heart Province, died on Thursday, January 23, 2020, at Holy Family Memorial Hospital in Manitowoc, WI, at the age of 89. Edward Skorup was born on March 18, 1930, in Chicago, IL, to Aemilian Skorup and Anna (Litviak) Skorup. He was baptized at St Michael Parish in Chicago, IL. Edward was received into the Franciscan community as a novice on July 4, 1952, and given the name Ildephonse. He professed solemn vows on July 5, 1956, and was ordained a priest by Bishop William O'Connor on June 24, 1959.

After ordination, Fr. Ildephonse studied at Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, OH, pursuing a degree in Education. He taught at Padua Franciscan High School in Cleveland, OH, for two years. For the next six years, he was a pastoral minister in two Missouri parishes. Education was his first priority, so he went back to teaching at St. Francis de Sales High School in Chicago, IL, for seventeen years. After a muchneeded sabbatical, Fr. Ildephonse changed ministries and became the

chaplain for the Franciscan Sisters of the Sacred Heart in Frankfort, IL. He retired in 2013 and moved to Blessed Giles Friary in Manitowoc.

Fr. Ildephonse was preceded in death by his parents, Aemilian and Anna Skorup; a sister, Ruth Skorup and a nephew, Chris Skorup; two sisters-inlaw, Marian Soukup and Marie Jeanne Abt. He is survived by his brother, Emil of Orland Park, IL; a niece, Madeleine (Thomas) Kwiatowski; two nephews, Mark (Karen) Skorup and Emil David Skorup; 8 great nieces and nephews and several great-great nieces and nephews, and his Franciscan family.
