SHREVEPORT, LA - The Reverend Luis William Antlitz, retired Catholic Priest of Shreveport, died Friday morning, August 28, 1992 at Nursecare Nursing Home after a lengthy illness.

Father Antlitz was born on March 10, 1901, in Watertown, South Dakota, and ordained into the priesthood on June 6, 1930, in Santa Barbara, California, by the Most Reverend John J. Cantrell. He was incarnated into the Diocese of Alexandria in October of 1966.

Father Antlitz served at parishes in California, Arizona, and New Mexico before coming to this area where he served in Moreauville, Alexandria, and Pineville. His last assignment was as pastor at St. Ann Church in Ebarb, Louisiana.

A vigil service will be held at Rose-Neath's Marshall Street Chapel at 7 p.m. on Sunday, August 30, 1992. A concelebrated mass of Christian burial will be held at St. Mary of the Pines Catholic Church on Monday, August 31, 1992 at 10 a.m. with Bishop William B. Friend of the Diocese of Shreveport presiding. Burial will take place at St. Ann Cemetery in Ebarb.
