

**FR. THOMAS M.
ANGLIM**

Fr. Thomas M. Anglim died in Carrigoran House in Ireland 81 years of age on January 19, 2010.

Fr. Thomas M. Anglim was born Nov. 15, 1928 in Feakle, County Clare Ireland. He attended National School and Mongret College in Limerick. At Mongret he was invited to join the seminary of St. Mary in Baltimore and became a priest for the Diocese of St. Augustine. He was ordained at the Shrine of Our Lady Le Leche in St. Augustine May 23, 1954. He served as Pastor in St. Mary's in St. Petersburg, Blessed Trinity in Miami Springs, Little Flower in Coral Gables, Holy Rosary in Perrine, and Sacred Heart Parish in Lake Worth and was appointed Pastor of St. Francis Xavier Church in Fort Myers in 1966. While at St. Francis Xavier Church Fr. Anglim oversaw the development of St. Francis Xavier School, coordinated the establishment of the new St. Therese Mission in N. Fort Myers, The Villa Francisco Apartments and the Dreams are Free Institute. Fr. Anglim was appointed Vicar General of the Diocese of Venice in 1986 and served the Diocese in that capacity until 2002. He retired as Pastor in 2004 and lived in Fort Myers before moving to Ireland. Fr. Anglim is survived by his brother, John, sister, Sister Agnes, sister-in-law Bernadette, nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Visitation will be at St. Francis Xavier Church, Sunday evening from 7-9 PM. There will be a Funeral Mass celebrated by Bishop Frank Dewane and the Priest of the Diocese of Venice on Monday at 2:00 PM.
