Rev. Joseph P. Sokol, 62, St. Joseph's Chaplain's Aide

Rockville Centre—Services will be held tonight and tomorrow for the Rev. Joseph P. Sokol, 62, assistant chaplain at St. Joseph's Villa, the residence for the sisters serving Mercy Hospital.

Father Sokol died in Mercy Hospital Monday. He was a native of Jersey City, studied at Seton Hall University and was ordained as a priest in 1935. Until 1960 he taught at Don Bosco Catholic High School in Ramsey, N.J. He served as assistant

pastor at parishes in Patchogue, Southampton and Lindenhurst. His last post was at Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Lindenhurst.

He is survived by four brothers, all of New Jersey. A Mass of the Resurrection is scheduled for 8 o'clock tonight in the chapel of St. Joseph's Villa. A Pontifical Concelebrated Mass of the Resurrection will be held at 11 AM tomorrow. Burial will be in the Cemetery of the Holy Cross, North Arlington, N.J.
