

## **Ordination Rites Slated For Seminary Graduate**

Scheduled to be ordained to the priesthood Saturday in Assumption Cathedral, Louisville, the Rev. Kent Pieper will offer his first Solemn High Mass at Blessed Sacrament Church, South Fort Mitchell, May 27. Christened Paul Pieper, he is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Herman Pieper, 31 Orphanage Rd., South Fort Mitchell.

A member of the Passionist Order, he is to be known in religious life as Father Kent. He is a graduate of St. Henry School and entered the Passionist College in St. Louis in 1939. He pronounced his vows in the Passionists Order in 1944 at St. Paul, Kans. He studied three years of philosophy at the Passionist Monastery, Detroit, then went on to the theology studies in Chicago and at the Passionist Monastery, Louisville.

On May 30 the newly ordained priest is to conduct the ceremonies and offer Nuptial High Mass at the marriage of his sister, Miss Mary Lee Pieper, to Eugene Merton at Blessed Sacrament Church.
