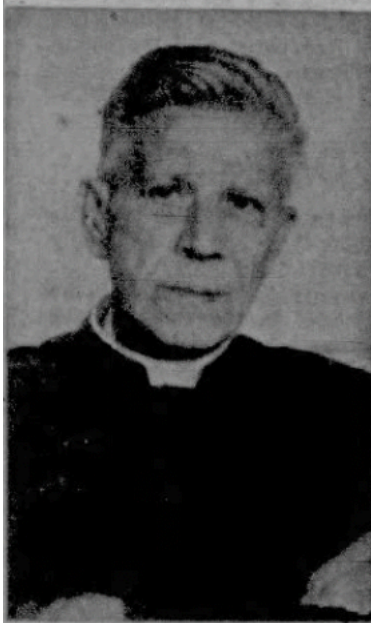


# Father Kuntz, SJC Teacher, Dies at 69

Rev. Lawrence Linus Kuntz, 69, of St. Jerome's College teaching staff, died at St. Mary's Hospital early today following a lengthy illness.

Born in Formosa, Ont., Dec. 29, 1882, he studied at St. Jerome's College and at Gregorian University, Rome. Following his ordination in 1914, he taught at St.

Jerome's and St. Stanislaus College, Chicago.

Father Kuntz later served in Louisville, Ky.; St. Louis RC Church, Waterloo, and at St. Agatha before returning to St. Jerome's infirmary.

He was known as an outstanding teacher and a fluent speaker. Father Kuntz was also one of the first "ham" radio operators in the Twin Cities about 1920.

Surviving are one brother, Albert, of Calgary and one sister, Mrs. Christine Benninger of London, Ont. Four sisters and four brothers predeceased him.

The body will be at St. Jerome's parlor until Tuesday at 4 p.m. when removal will be made to St. Mary's RC Church for funeral Wednesday at 10 a.m. Interment will be in Mount Hope Cemetery.
