

Tfrom the Pastor's Desk


Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,



We have received a quarterly update from the Archdiocese of Boston regarding Inspiring Hope. The total pledges made were \$742,455.72. Of the total pledged, \$525,190.88 has been collected as of December 31, 2023.

Please note that: Of the pledges collected, \$380,606.26 stays with Sacred Heart Parish and \$144,584.62 goes to the Cardinal's initiatives for Catholic Schools and administrative costs as outlined on our website:



Today might be the first day of your own spiritual renewal, the beginning of something good and something you've wanted to do for a while. Don't delay. Act now to practice what you believe, so that you will better believe what you practice.


