The son of Mr. and Mrs. O. G. Gremillion of 1524 Monroe street, Alexandria, a native of Cottonport, La. He received his early education at the Menard Memorial School here, leaving there to enter the preparatory Seminary at Saint Benedict, Louisiana, in the summer of 1923. After four years of studies there he entered the philosophy department of Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans, two years later, on October 15th, 1929, he left for Rome, Italy where he completed his theological course at the North American College. He was ordained to the priesthood there on December 8th, 1932, on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. Father Gremillion left Rome on April 24 on the Italian steamer, the Conte de Savoia for New York, arriving here this morning.
