

## ORDAINED PRIEST

Rev. Francis DeSales Donohoe, O. M. Cap., who was ordained to the priesthood in Washington Tuesday as a member of the Capuchin Order will sing his first solemn high mass at St. Mary's Church, Oldtown Road, this morning at 10 o'clock. He will be assisted by Rev. Francis S. Laing, pastor of Sacred Heart Church, Charleston, W. Va., an uncle, as arch-priest, and by Rev. Claude R. Kean, O. F. M. of St. Bonaventure College, New York, a cousin, as deacon. Both Father Laing and Father Kean are natives of Cumberland. Father Donohoe, whose name in religion is Rev. Francis DeSales, is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Hubert M. Donohoe, 341 Grand Avenue, this city.

The sermon at the ceremonies this morning will be preached by Very Rev. Sigmund Cratz, O. M. Cap., of Pittsburgh. After the mass the young priest will give his blessing to the congregation.

This evening he will officiate at the triple Benediction services at St. Mary's. Two of the services will be held at altars erected outdoors. They will be preceded by a procession in honor of the feast of Corpus Christi. The evening services will begin at 7:30 o'clock.
