

FATHER GILLES BOYER

Rev. Gilles Boyer new pastor of St. Edwards Church

The Rev. Gilles Boyer, a native of Canada who has served his church in Louisians for 16 years, has been appointed pastor of St. Edwards' Catholie Church in Tallulah.

Father Boyer replaces the Rev. Belton Scallan, who was transferred to St. Matthews' Catholie Church in Monroe after serving bere for two years.

Father Boyer has served for the past year as pastor of M. Clement's Courch in Visian-Gil City.

Born in St. Andre Avellin, Quebec, Canada, Father Boyer is one of nine children born to Mr. and Mrs. George Boyer. He made his ceclesiastical studies at St. Therese Seminary in the province of Quebec and also at the Ottawa Major Seminary in Outario, Canada, He taught in Bourget College in Quebec for one year.

The new St. Edwards' pastor was ordained for the Diocese of Alexandria by Bishop Charles P. Greeo on November 1, 1854 at Maryhill Seminary, Pineville, La.

Prior to coming to Tallulah, Father Boyer had been assistant pastor at St. Rita's Church in Alexandria and St. Alphonsus' Church in Hessmar, La. until 1861. He was then named pastor of St. Genevieves' in Brouillette, La. while there, he was involved in a near-fatal automobile accident in Pineville. theremosticals for 23 days, he was confined to Baptist Hospital in Alexandria for three montls.

After a slow recovery from his accident. Bishop Greec appointed him administrator of St. Anthony's Church in Cottonpert in January, 1963.

Father Boyer later served as pastor of St. Joseph's Church in Bunkie and pastor in the church in Rambin, La, with missions in Carmel and Benson before being transferred to Vivian and Oil City.
