Rev. G. P. Kinane To Be Ordained

Rev. Gerard P. Kinane, a native of Scranton, will be ordained a deacon for the Archdiocese of New Orleans in ceremonies June 10.

Rev. Kinane will be ordained at 6 p.m. in Our Lady of Prompt Succor Church, Chalmette, by Most Rev. Harold R. Perry, auxiliary bishop of New Orleans. He will continue to serve as a deacon at the Chalmette parish during the coming year while completing his studies for the priesthood at Notre Dame Seminary.

He attended Catholic schools in his native Scranton before going on to St. Philip Neri school in Boston. Since that time he has studied at St. Mary's College in Kentucky, St. Joseph's Seminary College in Covington, Immaculate Conception Seminary in Missouri, and at Notre Dame in New Orleans.

Rev. Kinane worked in the Desire Street Project Program during the summer of 1967 and with the Archdiocesan Witness Program in 1968 and 1969. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. John J. Kinane, Scranton.
