Archdiocesan Pastors Move Up Ranks

The appointments of three pastors and the naming of a co-pastor to be pastor were announced this week by the archdiocesan chancery office.

The Rev. Thomas G. Glasgow, co-pastor of St. Philip the Apostle parish in Gentilly, will assume duties

as sole pastor.

The Rev. Ignatius Roppolo, formerly co-pastor at St. Philip, will take over as pastor at Our Lady of Divine Providence parish, Metairie.

He has served as associate at St. Gabriel the Archangel, Mater Dolorosa and St. Philip parishes. He holds a bachelor of science degree, a master of divinity degree, and a master of social work degree earned at Tulane University.
