

Mosca to preach

Father Gregory Mosca, O.S.B., will preach a Lenten Mission at the Catholic Church of the Assumption beginning Saturday (anticipated Mass), March 3, and ending Thursday, March 8.

He will speak at all Masses Sunday, March 4. The evening service beginning Monday, March 5, will take place at 7 p.m. and will include Mass, a sermon by Father Mosca, and an opportunity for confession.

Father Mosca will also speak to the St. John Elementary students at an 8:15 a.m. Mass in church Tuesday, March 6; to the Hanson students at an 8:05 a.m. Mass Thursday, March 8, and to the students of the lower grades of the CCD program at a 5:30 p.m. Mass in church Wednesday, March 7.

Students in the upper CCD grades are to attend the regular Mission services in place of their weekly class. Plans are being made for Father Mosca to visit the Franklin Nursing Home for their Thursday morning Mass, and time permitting, to visit the shut-ins of the Church Parish.

A native of New York, Father Mosca ministered in Lake Charles a number of years and served as Pastor of St. Henry Church there. Since returning to his native state he has come to Louisiana a number of times to preach missions.

All are invited and urged to attend the Mission as an excellent means of beginning the Lenten season.
