

Rev. Salvatore Isgro, former principal at Don Bosco Prep, dies at age 59

Funeral services are scheduled tonight and tomorrow for the Rev. Salvatore Isgro of Stony Point, a former principal of the Don Bosco Preparatory School in New Jersey, and the Salesian High School in New Rochelle in Westchester County, who died Sunday at the age of 59.

A resident of the Blue Gate Convalescent Home at the time of his death, the Rev. Isgro was a former teacher and school administrator in Roman Catholic schools in New York and in Louisiana.

The Rev. Isgro was born in Schenectady, N.Y., on Sept. 12, 1931, to Pietro and Vennera D'Angelo Isgro.

Before moving to the convalescent home six years ago, he had lived in West Haverstraw since 1982, and before that in New Or-

leans, La., where he was the director of the Archbishop Shaw High School for two years, retiring in 1982.

Within the Salesian Order, he was the provincial of Eastern Province of the United States from 1973 to 1979.

The Rev. Isgro was the director and principal of Don Bosco Preparatory School in Ramsey, N.J. from 1971 to 1973, and was the administra-

tor of the Salesian High School in New Rochelle in Westchester in 1971.

Before assuming those positions,

he had held teaching and administrative positions in Goshen, in Orange County, and in West Haverstraw, Boston, and East Boston, Mass.

Survivors include three brothers, Carman, Anthony and Joseph Isgro, all of Schenectady.

A wake service is scheduled tonight at 8 in the Don Bosco Chapel in West Haverstraw.

Calling hours are scheduled today from 2 to 5 and 7 to 9 p.m., at the chapel.

A Mass of Christian Burial is scheduled tomorrow at noon at the chapel. Burial will be at the Salesian Cemetery in Goshen.
