



### **Brother George Curtis, FSC**

LAFAYETTE — A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday, Dec. 17, 1998, at De La Salle-Christian Brothers of Lafayette for Brother George Curtis, FSC, 87, who died Monday, Dec. 14, 1998, at Oakwood Village Nursing Home.

Interment will be in the De La Salle Cemetery.

Born Feb. 22, 1911, in New Iberia, Brother George was the son of George Curtis and the former Camille Mestayer, both deceased.

Survivors include his sister, Sister Adelaide Curtis, D.C.; one nephew, Henry George Mouret and his wife, Jeanette Mouret, of New Iberia; one great-nephew; and two great-nieces.

He was preceded in death by his sister, Dean Mouret, and his brother, Brother Alex Curtis, FSC.

Brother George entered the Junior Novitiate of the Christian Brothers in 1923, and received the religious habit of the Brothers July 1, 1927. He made final profession of vows June 20, 1936. Throughout his teaching career, Brother George was stationed in 12 Christian Brothers Schools in the New Orleans-Santa Fe Province. In addition, he served as director of vocations for the western section of the province from 1961 to 1964.

Visitation hours will be observed at De La Salle-Christian Brothers from 9 to 11 a.m. Thursday, with a rosary to be recited at 9 a.m.
