Van Hoorn was ordained to the Holy Priesthood, July 25, 1955 in Nymegen, Netherlands. He came to the Diocese of Alexandria where he served at St. Joseph in Mansfield and Marksville, Sacred Heart, Pineville, Our Lady of Prompt Succor, Alexandria, Immaculate Heart, Tioga and Chaplain at St. Frances Cabrini Hospital, St. Anthony, Bunkie and St. Catherine, Shreveport. He was fluent in the languages of English, German, French and Dutch. He retired in 1983.
