The Rev. Joseph Suppe; Retired Priest

The Rev. Joseph V. Suppe of Waterbury, a priest, died Sunday at St. Mary's Hospital in Waterbury. He was 50.

The Rev. Suppe was appointed assistant pastor of St. Paul Church in West Haven on Sept. 10, 1987. After his retirement, he assisted at the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem.

The Rev. Suppe was previously assistant pastor of St. Margaret Church in Waterbury and assistant pastor of St. John the Evangelist

Church in Watertown.

The Rev. Suppe was born in Branford. He graduated from St. Rose Grammar School in New Haven, Notre Dame High School in West Haven, St. Thomas Seminary in Bloomfield and St. John Seminary in Brighton, Mass.

He was ordained on May 25, 1974, in the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Hartford by the Most Rev. John F. Whealon, the late archbishop of Hartford.
