New Priests To Be Assigned To Fresno Diocese

Rev. John J. Gaynor of Pennsylvania and Rev. Thomas E. Farrell of Massachusetts have been ordained for service in the Catholic Diocese of Monterey-Fresno and will take up their duties here soon.

Rev. Gaynor served with the United States Marine Corps in France during the world war and later in Cuba, Haiti, Porto Rico and the Virgin Islands. He was discharged with the rank of sergeant in 1925 and resumed his education in high school and college in Atchison, Kan. He attended St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore and the St. Thomas Seminary, Denver. He was ordained May 30th in Philadelphia and will report Thursday for duty as assistant in the St. John's Cathedral.

Rev. Farrell attended St. Benedict's School in Atchison, St. Charles' College, Cantonville, Md., and St. Bonaventure's Seminary, Allegheny, N. Y. He was ordained Saturday in Springfield, Mass. Rev. James Culleton, the chancellor, says Rev. Farrell probably will be assigned to a parish in Hollister

beginning July 1st.
