

## Cathedral Assistant Gets Dinuba Pulpit

Rev. John P. Boyle, who has been an assistant at St. John's Cathedral for four years, has been appointed pastor of the newly established Dinuba parish.

St. Catherine's Church in Dinuba, a former mission of the Reedley church, is the parish seat, and St. Mary's Church of Cutler, also a former mission of the Reedley church, has been transferred to the new parish.

Rev. Boyle is a native of California, and has spent most of his life in the Monterey-Fresno Diocese.

After early studies for the priesthood in St. Joseph's Seminary, Mountain View, he was sent to the Catholic University of America, Washington, D. C., where he received a master's degree in social science in 1939. He then studied in Rome, where he attended the North American College, the Collegio Capranica and the Gregorian University.

He was ordained in Rome in 1941 by a special dispensation two years before his scheduled ordination date, because wartime regulations would not have allowed him to remain there to continue his studies.

Before he was appointed to the cathedral, he served in Los Banos and Watsonville. He has been secretary of the diocesan matrimonial court for the past five years.
