Rev. Philip Grill to Conduct Mass

The Rev. Philip Grill, former Mary Star of the Sea school student who later attended Dana Junior and San Pedro high school, will say a high mass at 11:30 a. m. tomorrow at the Mary Star of the Sea church.

A graduate of Loyola high school, Mr. Grill later attended Los Angeles Junior seminary, and finished his studies in philosophy, scripture and theology at St. Patrick's and St. John's seminary. He was ordained April 27 to the Roman Catholic priesthood by Archbishop John J. Cantwell at St. Vibiana's cathedral.

A resident of San Pedro from 1929 to 1939, he is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Philip A. Grill and a brother of Mrs. Bernard Smith of 791 W. Fifteenth st.

He already has been assigned to serve as assistant pastor of the All Saints church in Los Angeles.
