

Fr. Quinlan called by death

The Rev. Fr. Celestine Quinlan, OFM, Cap., whose foresight resulted in the construction of St. Mary's school, died Tuesday in Bend, Ore., after a brief illness.

Funeral services will be conducted Friday at St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church in Bend.

Fr. Quinlan was born in Cork City, Ireland, on Feb. 6, 1902. In 1918 he joined the Capuchin-Franciscan order and was ordained on June 25, 1929.

His first assignment in this country was as assistant pastor at St. Mary of the Angels Church in Ukiah in 1934. He was pastor at St. Mary's from 1949 to 1956 at which time he went to Willits where he served as pastor from 1962 to 1968.

He was then transferred to Bend where he served as chaplain of St. Charles Hospital.

Fr. Quinlan is survived by a brother and sister living in Ireland.

He was a member of Rotary for many years.
